NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Detroit City Planning Commission in the Committee of the Whole Room, 13th Floor, Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, 2 Woodward Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226 at the date and time listed below. Both in-person and virtual attendance are options to participate. Pursuant to public health guidelines and limited room capacity, if anyone has cold, flu, COVID symptoms or other contagious condition, virtual attendance is strongly encouraged. The public hearing is to consider the request of Jerome Morgan and the City Planning Commission (CPC) as a co-petitioner to replace the existing PD (Planned Development) zoning classification at 101 Lenox and 319 Lenox Avenue, the authorization for which has lapsed, with a new PD and site plan. The subject area was rezoned to PD in 1987 via Ordinance #25-87 with the City Council approving the site plan in 2007 for 18 new single-family houses. The proposed PD would amend Article XVII, Section 50-17-33, District Map No. 31, Chapter 50 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Zoning*. The subject area is generally located on the west side of Lenox Avenue between Avondale Street and the Detroit River. Please see the attached map for reference.

The proposed PD at 101 Lenox Avenue would be to redevelop the currently vacant site with 16 single-family houses. The proposed PD at 319 Lenox Avenue would not be for residential development, but rather developed by the City's Parks and Recreation Department for parkland.

The PD zoning district is generally defined by the Zoning Ordinance as follows:

PD – PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

This district will permit planned developments throughout the City and will be particularly useful in urban renewal areas. Such planned developments shall be substantially in accord with the goals and objectives of the Master Plan, by having a major land use that corresponds to the most general category of land use, which are Residential, Public/Civic/Institutional, Retail/Service/Commercial, Manufacturing, and Industrial, and Other, proposed in the Master Plan for the area involved. Such planned developments shall provide a desirable environment for the uses proposed and shall not be out of harmony with their general surroundings. The regulations of the district are designed to accomplish this by permitting flexibility in overall development while ensuring adequate safeguards and standards for public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare and, where applicable, encouraging historic preservation.

All interested persons are invited to be present and be heard as to their views. Persons making oral presentations are encouraged to submit written copies, for the record, to the City Planning Commission via e-mail at cpc@detroitmi.gov. Public comment/testimony may be given at the

appropriate times when called for during the meeting. If you desire to speak and are attending the meeting online, press the “raise your hand” icon at the bottom of the screen or press ALT-Y for a PC or OPT-Y for a MAC to raise your hand virtually. If attending by phone press *-9 to raise your hand.

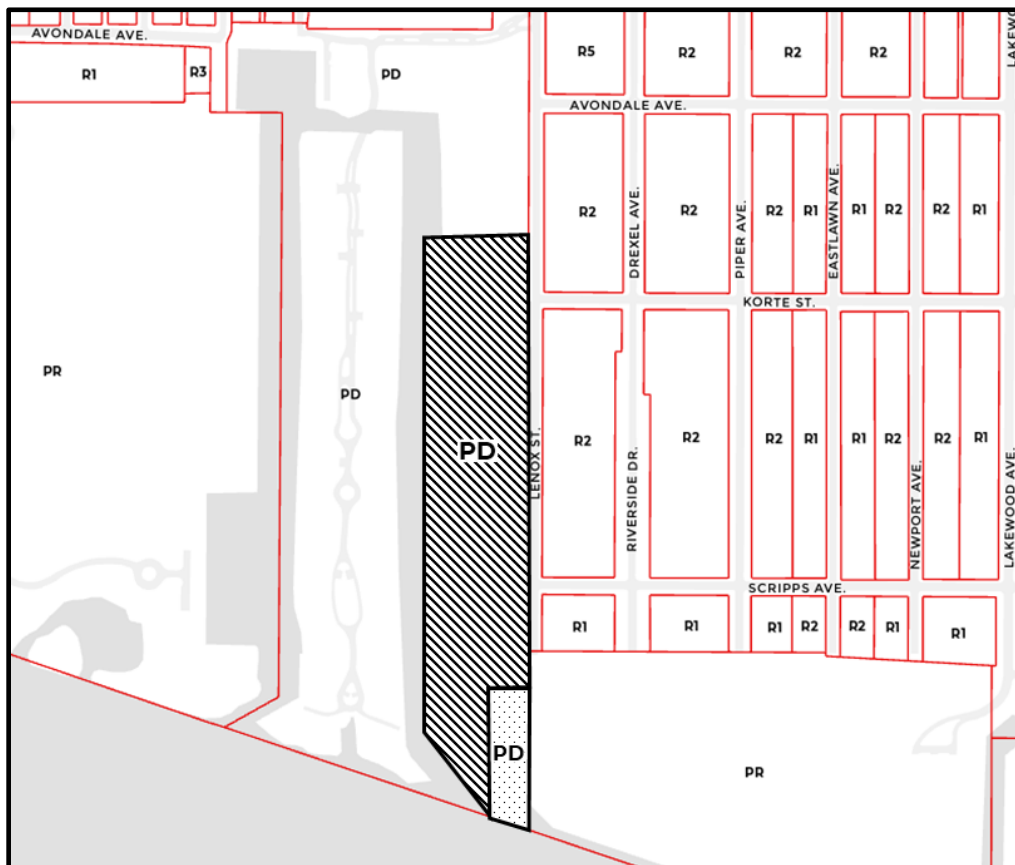
